Maryland DGS Awards Contract to Woman-Owned Business

Contract Has a \$3.7 Million Dollar Value

(LANHAM – June 4) – Dozier Technologies, Inc. (DTI), a dynamic professional facilities management and creative services firm located in Lanham, MD, received final approval on a nearly \$4 million contract by the Maryland Board of Public Works.

DTI, based in Prince George’s County, was selected by the Maryland Department of General Services’ (DGS) Division of Procurement and Logistics to provide Mail Management, Courier/Delivery, and Messenger services to DGS, the Department of Safety and Correctional Service, as well as, other Maryland agencies upon request.

Hence, DTI is the prime contractor on this fixed price contract, which has an initial base period of two years and three option years.
